## West Side Summer Reading 2025

## Summer Reading Requirement (100 pts):

- Each student will keep a journal of one (1) fiction book from the list provided below.
- Must turn in ONE spiral bound notebook or binder. Journals can be typed (preferred) or written. A physical copy of the journal must be turned in.
- A journal entry will be kept for <u>EACH chapter</u> of the required book. Entries MUST include:
  - A list of each character appearing in a chapter.,
  - In only a few words, give basic information about each character (if the character is appearing for the first time)
  - On the first line, include the date, pages read, and chapter title (if applicable).
  - Skip one line, then write one 5-7 sentence summary of the chapter read.
  - Give at least 2 additional sentences as a personal reflection about the portion read. How has this portion affected you personally? (Thoughts, feelings, etc)
  - If reading Screwtape Letters (10th grade), you will be required to write 2-3 lines of summary and 5-7 on personal reflection on EVERY 2 chapters, not every single chapter.
    - \*\*\*Be sure to add a quote which you found enlightening from each chapter. Tell why. This can be part of your 5-7 sentence reflection.
- At the end of your journal, include a half page paragraph on your overall opinion of the book. Did you enjoy the book? Can you relate to any of the characters? Which is your favorite character? Least favorite? Did you like the plot? Were there holes in the plot? Etc.
- For 9th-12th grade, <u>students must also take the accompanying BOOK QUIZ</u>. Reach out to one of your teachers to take it this summer or take it when you get back to school.
- This assignment, along with the completion form attached, will be due the first day of school this fall (August 2025) but can be turned in at any time this summer.
